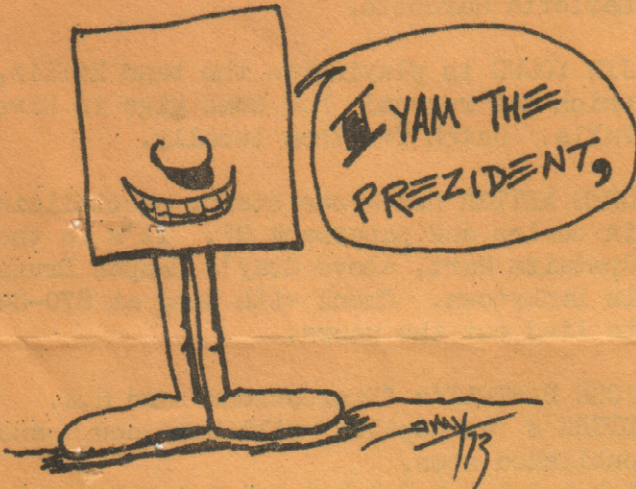

Gofers are needed. Call Don Bailey, 374-5474, to volunteer.

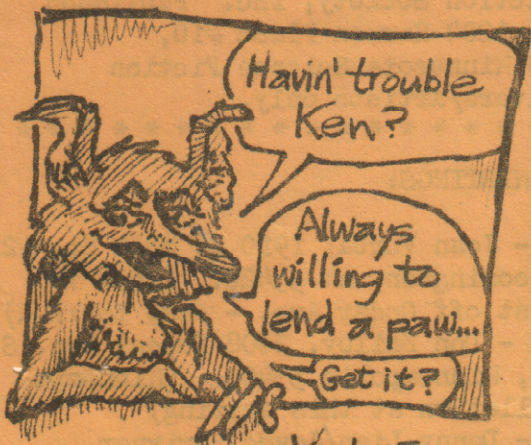
There will be a special-edition book available at Minicon, Theodore Sturgeon's novelette Maturity and a bibliography. The price is \$10.

WHAT THE MEMBERS ARE DOING THESE DAYS:

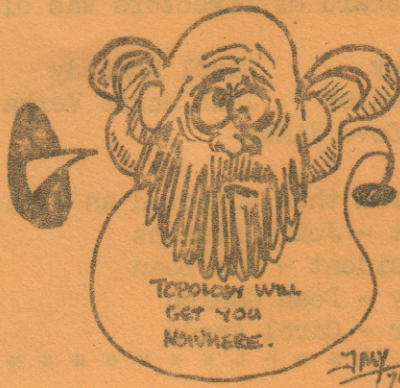
NATE BUCKLIN, along with Al Standish, Reed Waller, and Karen Hill, is playing in a touring band backing country singer Carlotta Marcotte.
